Do you need home care and support (home nursing / Hauskrankenpflege)?

Carers (e.g., qualified healthcare and nursing staff, care assistants) will support you with services such as:



- continued medical care and personal care (e.g., wound dressing change, personal hygiene, administering medication, etc.)
- organising an emergency telephone (call assistance) and a food delivery service
- household chores and errands, such as shopping and trips to the pharmacy

What are the costs?

- The initial consultation is free of charge (90-minute initial consultation).
- The costs are calculated on the basis of the customer's net income. The amount also depends on the qualifications of the carer or caregiver. The care allowance (Pflegegeld) does not count as income.
- Proof of income and the residence registration form (Meldezettel) are required.



Health insurance pays a share of the costs for each home visit for medical home nursing care (e.g., for wound dressing change). A doctor's prescription is required for this. You can obtain this from your family doctor.

Make an appointment

You can contact your local care and support service or home nursing service yourself. Make an appointment for an initial consultation. The home care and support service depends on your place of residence. Your family doctor, the municipality where you live, or the care hub (Pflegedrehscheibe) in your district can tell you the specific contact person.
